Some details in the insignia of the *proconsul Africae* could be considered the allusions to the legal position of *proconsul Africae* and the role of *Africa Proconsularis* in delivering supplies for Rome. As many other details in the insignia of the *Notitia Dignitatum* they are accurate and enable one to arrive at quite an orderly picture of the functions of imperial officials.



They were possibly added also to strengthen the association of the information contained in the text of *Notitia Dignitatum* with the province which *proconsul Africae* had in charge.
